Before joining ERGO Group, he worked in various change management and leadership development activities at HDI, Victoria, and the Allianz Group.

Mario is formal Board member and currently Executive Advisor of the EFMD. He was the facilitator of the EFMD Special Interest Group on “Leadership development 2.0”. He is also a member of the Academic Board of DUW.
